This includes, snow/ice removal, room set-ups, landscaping duties, etc.

Essential Responsibilities:

- The Plumber is responsible for plumbing installation and repair throughout NCC locations including residential, school and facility settings.
- Plan and complete all necessary steps in the installation, maintenance, repair and servicing in water and drain systems.
- Plumbers are required to perform work on various plumbing systems, including instillations.
- Install sinks, toilets, bathtubs, showers and other type of appliances.
- Responsible for troubleshooting plumbing related matters including instillations, repairs and maintenance of plumbing systems.
- Address instances of system malfunctions, interruptions and failures.
- Collaborate with HVAC Technicians on work assignments.
- Use a variety of hand and power tools equipment in performing duties.
- Comply with safety regulations and maintain clean and orderly work areas.
- Can be called into to work outside of business hours for emergencies.
- Communicate with Property Manager with building related work projects/issues.
- Document work completed
